Fred Pederson was born Oct, 1872 in Rubjerg, Denmark. His parents were Peter Toft Petersen and Kirsten "Carrie" Nielsdatter. He was baptized on Oct 31, 1881 Rubjerg, Denmark.

He came to the US in 1889-90.

On Dec 21, 1892, Fred married Jessie Nannie Kevan in Shelby County, Iowa. Jessie was born in Shelby County, Iowa. Her parents were Andrew and Sarah Kevan. Jessie was born April 12, 1875. She was 18 years old when she was married.

In 1900 census, Fred & Jessie and family are living in Harlan. He lists his occupation as a drayman. He indicates on the census that both he and Jessie read, write and speak English. They own a home. Jessie's Father was born in Pennsylvania and mother was born in Ohio.

In the 1910 census Fred & Jessie and family live in Douglas Township, Shelby Cnty, Iowa. Jessie indicates he is a farmer. Fred is renting a farm.

At some time after the census was taken in 1910 and before June, 6, 1911, Fred and Jessie move the family to a farm near Trenton, Mo (Grundy County). Fred would have been approx. 39 years old when they move to Missouri and would have had 6 kids. With the oldest being approx. 16.

In 1920, Fred, Jessie and family lived in Trenton Township, Grundy County Missouri. According to the census, Fred was a farmer. They had a couple that was living with them as Lodgers. Pearl, Leighton, Grant, and Howard are not at home.

In 1930 census, Mae (19) and Harold (15) are still living the household. Fred lists his occupation as a Farmer.

Jessie died Oct 3, 1937. Buried in Trenton Township, Grundy County, Mo

In 1940 census, Fred (67 years of age) is a widower. He has a house keeper and hired hand (married) living with him. He lives in Lincoln Township, Grundy County, Mo.

Fred Pederson died Apr 8, 1947.

This database contains passenger lists of ships that departed from the port of Hamburg, Germany from 1850-1934 (with a gap from 1915-1919 due to World War I). The database includes images of the passenger lists digitized from microfilm in partnership with the Hamburg State Archive, available here for the first time online. It also includes a complete index for the years 1877-1914 (up to the start of World War I).

And later was transferred to Joliet, Ill. With Caterpillar Tractor Co. until his retirement at which time they moved to Portland, Oregon area where he died 2005 and Lorene and still lives.
